

AUSTRALIAN BAT LYSSAVIRUS VACCINATION FOLLOW-UP

All flying-fox/bat carers who have had lyssavirus vaccination should have titre levels checked annually to ensure immunity is maintained. Vaccination boosters should be administered as considered necessary by a medical practitioner, based on titre level readings. **NTWC require that carers with a reading of 0.5 or less way not be used until a booster has been given. Carers with readings between 0.5 and 1.0 should be advised that their immunity is low and a booster considered.** Carers should arrange for this form to be completed by their medical practitioner. The form should then be forwarded to their Group/Branch Coordinator as shown below.
